- STC Budget / precept for 2019/20: Councillors approved the budget for the next financial year. The precept (Council tax) for 2019 / 20 will be £352,000 with a 5.6% increase on the previous year as an overall total but as a comparable to band D properties it is an overall increase of 2.6%, approx. £5 per year.
- The STC Community Awards for 2019 have been launched, nomination forms can be found in Viaduct, Somerton Library and on the Town Council website. Closing date for nominations is 30th April 2019, with the winners being announced at the Annual Parish Meeting on 31st May 2019.
- A presentation/consultation re the new school will take place on 31st January 2019 from 3:15pm at King Ina Academy Junior School
- Councillor Peter Frayne has resigned from the Town Council. Peter was chairman of the Land and Properties Committee, Chairman of the Council Dean Ruddle paid tribute to the work completed by Peter during his time on the council and thanked him for his contribution to Somerton.
- STC agreed to implement the Councillor Allowances from May 2019, the allowance will be £450pa for all elected councillors.
- Library update: The Library Trust have achieved charity status and are in advanced talks with the County Council to secure an agreement that will retain a library in Somerton. The new trust will become operational from April 2019.
- Recreation Ground Trust: The transition of moving from the Town Council being the sole trustee and moving to a new trust in the form of an CIO is anticipated to be operational from April 2019. Cllr Bassett will be the STC representative on the new Recreation Ground Trust.
- The improved Disabled Access project at the Recreation Ground is nearing completion.
- Fireworks have been booked for November 2019, to be hosted at the Recreation Ground on 2nd November, after the success of the event in 2018.
- The winner of the domestic Christmas Lights competition will be announced at the February Full Council meeting. The winner will receive a cheque for £50 and a trophy.




