SAFE PLACES UPDATE

The Somerton Safe Places scheme, originally organised by SADAA (Somerton Area Dementia Action Alliance) in 2018, was designed to assist anyone who might get lost or disorientated in the town. Now, with reduced police involvement, an officer will only attend if there is a significant risk to someone's safety. This means we have to re-think the way the scheme works. It is proposed that responsibility shifts to a wider, Community-led group; the emphasis is on all vulnerable people, not only those living with dementia; and the aim is to produce a 'Safer Somerton', which is now the working title. SOMERTON SPEEDWATCH

Speedwatch has even more new members so be aware that we are covering a great many of Somerton roads and our equipment allows us to pick you up if you are speeding a long distance away from where we are standing. Are you aware that on average 1200 children a year are hit by vehicles which are exceeding the speed limit on 20mph roads! Nationally 3700 young people a year aged 17 or under have been hit and 16% of these collisions ended in fatalities with others seriously injured. If you drive at 20mph and hit a pedestrian they have a 1.5% chance of being killed against 8% if you are travelling at 30mph. We unfortunately see far too many people driving with children who are completely unaware of what might happen. PLEASE THINK ABOUT IT, it might be your children or grandchildren who are added to the statistics. Speeds below 20mph are VITAL in built up areas giving you the driver the chance to stop the car in time to avoid hitting pedestrians and cyclists. It is deeply concerning that 1/3rd of drivers still do not slow down for 20mph areas and instead selfishly prioritise their journey time over the safety of others. 
