SOMERTON LIBRARY

As forecast in the last edition, the Library reopened for limited business on 7 September. Less than a week later Somerset Libraries Service decided that the scope of the services – and some of the nomenclature – needed to be changed.

From Monday 14th September, the upgraded service includes:

'Library Choice' – (previously 'Order and Collect') mainly for customers whose local library is not yet open for browsing and are happy for library staff to choose a selection of books, talking books or DVDs, from items on the shelves in the library. Customers will be advised when their order is ready for collection from the library. Orders may be collected by a third party on behalf of the customer.

'Customer Request Service' - customers will once again be able to reserve items from the library catalogue https://www.librarieswest.org.uk and the LibrariesWest App, for pick up from libraries in Somerset. There is an initial limit of 10 reservations per library member to help manage demand. Customers will receive an automated email or SMS when reserved items becomes available for collection. Items are held for 14 days. Reservation charges apply on collection.

Public Computers - on Thursday and Friday afternoons two public computers are available for pre-booked, time-limited slots.

Loan Period and Charges - from Monday 14th September the 'usual' loan periods (e.g. 21 days for books.) are reinstated and, from the same date, overdue charges, hire fees and reservation charges will be reintroduced.

SOMERTON FOODBANK

Firstly, I would like to thank everyone who has been so generous with their donations to the foodbank, both in groceries and in cash, please keep on giving as everything you donate is appreciated very much.

We are in desperate need of a new venue for the foodbank as we are shortly going to lose our space in the Unicorn, please call us on 07561 651372 if you can help. The way that you access the foodbank has changed, you can no longer self refer. This is to ensure that everyone who approaches us gets all the help they need in claiming benefits and other entitlements, maintaining their tenancies and getting the ongoing support they need at difficult times.

This is what you need to do:

If you live in a social rented property, such as Yarlington, you should contact your landlord's tenancy support team for a referral.

If you own your own home, or rent privately, you should contact the Welfare Advice Team at South Somerset District Council or Citizens Advice for a referral. If you currently have a support worker, please ask them to contact us direct on the foodbank number below.

Our plan to set up a Good Neighbours Scheme has already been reported in previous editions of the Viaduct. We need to organise now to ensure Somerton can again rise to the challenge and provide the support needed. Our present suggestion would involve a list of volunteers in each area of Somerton, with a co-ordinator who receives requests and matches them to volunteers. Dividing the town up in this way will ensure no one person is overloaded, and that help can be offered on a neighbourhood basis.

The first priority is to offer a befriending service (mainly by phone) to those who are isolated or lonely, for which we can offer training and support to volunteers. As the scheme develops, we anticipate offering other help, such as transport and gardening, as well as carrying on some of the services currently provided by Lifeline.

If you already volunteer with Lifeline, we would love to know if you are interested in continuing for any or all of these forms of help. If you are not currently volunteering, we would be equally happy to hear if you would like to help.
