They recounted their war stories as soldiers, sailors, evacuated children, factory workers, nurses and from many others. The stories were collated by a local lady who produced the book, this was a community effort to ensure this part of Somerton's history lived on. The remaining copies are now being sold in remembrance of D-Day + 80 years.




