

Wessex Country Market

Saturday mornings 9:00 – 12:00 in The Unicorn skittle alley, you will find the Wessex Country Market. If you have never been then you are missing a treat!

The Wessex Country Market developed from the WI market and is now a limited company and has to adhere to all the rules and regulations of other food suppliers along with a few more, due to Natasha's Law. You will find beautiful homemade cakes, savouries, jams and pickles with full lists of ingredients, and those ingredients have been sourced as locally as possible, home-grown produce has been made into beautiful preserves alongside local honey too!

Other local produce includes meat, vegetables, cheese, butter and eggs, not only are these items locally sourced and food miles are so low, but you can also chat to the growers and producers. Who doesn't like the chance to shop all homemade, locally sourced and not a worldwide conglomerate in sight? You can also place advance orders to collect the following week.

Wessex Country Market has been in existence as it is since 1982. Christine Ward is the market manager, and Marlene Gibbs is the treasurer/secretary, but the country market runs as a group with decisions being made collectively. If you are interested in joining them, please contact Christine on 07971 079391, she would be happy to tell you all about the group and how to become part of the country market.

Alongside the grocery items, there are many crafts and talented makers. Sellers have all sorts to offer, handmade jewellery, felted animals, children's clothing, sheepskin rugs, turned wood goods, quilts and much more.

Wessex Country Market boasts 30 suppliers on the books, and the crafters tend to rotate so if you go one week, the next week will offer a different selection to browse. One of the local sellers is Jo Frith MBE who is an Olympic gold medallist from Rio 2016, she sells stunning watercolours and if you have ever considered having your pet immortalised she would be someone to consider.

Chris and Kayleigh who run The Unicorn are passionate about supporting Wessex Country Market and to preserve the opportunity for the residents of Somerton to shop locally for their goods.

So, if you are keen on shopping locally, keeping food miles to a minimum and living as sustainably as possible why not visit The Wessex Market on a Saturday morning.

NHS HEALTH CHECK

Anyone aged between 40 – 75 years who does not have a pre-existing health condition should be invited to a NHS Health Check by your GP or local council every 5 years.

Your NHS Health Check is a free check-up of your overall health, which can tell you whether you are at a higher risk of getting certain health problems i.e., heart disease, diabetes, kidney disease and strokes.

The check is completed by a healthcare professional and usually takes around 20 – 30 minutes to complete. The check usually involves taking the following measurements;

Height and Weight | Waist | Blood Pressure | Cholesterol | Possible Blood Sugar Level

You will also be asked questions surrounding the following;

**Smoking Habits | Alcohol Habits | Physical Activity Level | Family History
Age | Gender | Ethnicity**

Results and methods used to reduce risks are discussed during the appointment.

If you have not been invited but think you are eligible, contact your GP surgery to find out if they offer NHS Health Checks. Some pharmacies also offer NHS Health Checks.
