

Banksy in Ukraine - and Somerton!

In 2022 the anonymous artist Banksy, known for his provocative and political street art, travelled to Borodyanka, Ukraine, and graffitied a number of buildings which had been destroyed by Russian shelling. One of the designs became a symbol for the world's support for Ukraine and optimism in the face of a stronger opponent. The famous image was featured on a limited edition stamp, issued by the Ukrainian



postal service, on the first anniversary of Russia's invasion. Marc Pairon, an author and artist, was later commissioned to publish a limited edition art book, curating the work of Banksy in Ukraine and documenting how the commemorative stamp came about. Recently, a professionally framed set of the commemorative stamps, and a copy of Marc Pairon's book, were donated by Nick Pearson to be auctioned in Somerton and the proceeds given to benefit people in Ukraine. The auction was organised by Althea and Brian Pearson, who facilitate a support group known as 'Route 54' for Ukrainians in the Langport and Somerton area (the majority of whom live along the section of the 54 bus route between Fivehead and Street). Bidding took place during an exhibition of Ukrainian Arts and Crafts in Somerton organised by Sherry Briggs to showcase the outstanding art and craft achievements of some of the Ukrainian members. The winning bid - of £535 - was announced by Nick Pearson on the final day of the exhibition. A cheque for that amount was later presented to Galyna Tryndyuk, from Zerno Aid for Ukraine: Somerset group that buys medical items to save the lives of military personnel and civilians in Ukraine and which works closely with Reflex Medical, a Somerset company. The money has been used to buy tourniquets, bandages, gas masks and insulin and we have received heartfelt messages of gratitude from Ukrainian medical staff. We would like to record our grateful thanks to Nicholas Pearson for his magnanimous donation of the Banksy items; to those who placed bids and to the winning couple for their generous bid; and to those who promoted the auction. The amount raised brought tears to the eyes of Galyna, who was present when the auction's winning bid was announced. Thank you to all who visited the exhibition and purchased items. The artists received their own sales amount, some of which was donated to Ukraine. Thanks also to those who generously donated through the collecting boxes, which totalled £586 and to those who made contributions during the following week. When the proceeds of the Banksy auction were added to this total, we were able to donate over £1400 to Zerno Aid for Ukraine.


