Somerton Town Youth Football Club

Celebrating our 1st Anniversary. Over the last year, Somerton Town Youth Football Club has been working to increase the number of girls playing football through its Wildcat training sessions for girls aged 5 to 11. With support from the FA, Somerset FA and Bloor Homes, it now supports over 60 girls to play football in our community.

To build on their success from 2024 they are looking for adult volunteers (18+) to help:

- Starting a soccer school for girls aged 4 to 6
- Grow Wildcat sessions to increase participation of girls aged 5 to 11
- Start an U9 girls' team
- Start an U11 girls' team

No previous coaching experience is required as Somerton Town Youth Football Club will provide the necessary training and DBS checks.

They have had great success in supporting girls to play football and to increase female volunteers during 2024. You could join them on the next part of their journey.

Edgar Community Hall




