- Remembrance Sunday (12th November) Councillor Ruddle will lay a wreath on behalf of STC.
- Work is progressing on a possible one-way system on West Street. Various schemes will be consulted on after more information is received from Somerset County Highways.
- National Lottery "Awards for All" has given a grant of £8750 to fund a new electronic notice board.
- Tree pollarding is planned for Broad Street and the Market Square on 29th October.
- Car Park signage is nearly complete and white lining will be completed by the end of November
- Cemetery: Awaiting contractor to confirm start date for road. Entrance porch has been painted.
- Trees on the Langport Road have recently been inspected by the SSDC Tree Officer with no works planned at this stage.
- Pavement works adjacent to White Hart have been delayed until spring 2018

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE KNOLE CAUSEWAY, LONG SUTTON

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE B3151 STREET HILL

(Between Compton Dundon and Marshall's Elm). This road will be closed overnight from 1900 to 0700 from Monday 6th to Friday 11th November and again from Monday 4th to Friday 8th December for resurfacing work. The diversion route will be via the B3153 and Christian's Cross.
